WIRE IDENTIFICATION:

GD = Ground, White (Attach to vehicle frame)

TM = Taillight, Brown

LT = Left Turn/Brake, Yellow

RT = Right Turn/Brake, Green

AX = Auxiliary, Red (Ensure connection to fuse block or fused battery lead, 20 Amp)

EB = Electric Brakes, Blue

BU = Reverse, Purple

1. Attach the universal harness wires to the appropriate function wires from the tow vehicle using the wire identification chart above.
2. Route harness through the mounting bracket on vehicle.
3. Apply dielectric grease to terminals on both front and back of connector to prevent corrosion.
4. Plug the 7-blade and 4-flat connector into the mating plug from the universal harness. Ensure connector is fully inserted with locking tabs.
5. Securely mount assembled connector to a bracket or tow vehicle.
6. Test all functions with vehicle running.

NOTE: Locate wires and pin location by function only. Color coding is not standard among manufacturers.
